

MOVE OUT CLEANING CHECKLIST

Our goal is to refund your entire Security Deposit! This checklist is designed to assist us both in achieving that goal.

- It is your responsibility to return the property empty and in a clean condition, as cleaning issues are rarely considered to be normal wear and tear.
- If the property is not satisfactorily cleaned, and/or has trash or abandoned items, appropriate charges will be deducted from your Security Deposit. If hiring someone to clean the property is necessary, contracted labor costs much more than if you took the time to clean the home properly yourself.
- If staining, excessive dirtiness, or heavy traffic patterns are present on the carpeted surfaces, we highly-recommend-professional-carpet-cleaning as these items exceed normal wear and tear. If our inspection finds carpet conditions that exceed normal wear and tear, charges will apply for professional carpet cleaning. General:

Walls should be washed, or marks removed
Holes in walls should be restored to their original condition from
move-in
If there are any large holes, such as from wall anchors, the holes will
need to be patched, and the entire wall painted
Remove all cobwebs from walls and ceilings
Wall and ceiling vents should be vacuumed and washed
Clean the exterior surface of the light switch plates
Floors in the kitchen and bath or any linoleum should be cleaned
Fireplace(s) should be clean of all debris, including ashes

 □ Drapes should be vacuumed □ Window blinds should be dusted and cleaned □ Light bulbs should be replaced where needed □ Light covers should be cleaned and dusted from light fixtures □ Everything must be removed from closets (including coat hangers), and shelves must be cleaned
